### REGISTRATION BEGINS FEBRUARY 4, 2019

#### JUNE 17-21—OCEANOGRAPHERS

We will enjoy a beach filled week with sand in our shoes. Campers will enjoy surfing and going on a sea shell hunt. In story time, we will learn about the Wright Bothers and the pirates that visited our coastline. In the movement/activity room, we will walk the plank and try some shagging to beach music. For our art, we will make pirate flags and put a message in a bottle. Snacks will include pirate booty and watermelon.

#### JUNE 24-28—PROFESSIONAL ATHLETES

Baseball, football, hockey, and basketball are all fun sports we support locally. We will run the bases and do the wave while listening to sports themed songs. In story time, we will read the book Salt in His Shoes and The Boy Who Never Gave Up. In the movement/activity room, we will listen to Kids Bop's "Party Rock Anthem!" In art we will make our own jerseys. For snack we will have super bowl snack mix and oranges for recovery.

#### JULY 1- 5 (CLOSED JULY 4TH) — PIONEERS

We will go back in time and see what it was like to be a kid in colonial times like singing "Ring Around the Rosey" and playing "Tug of War." During story time, we will hear about North Carolina's past and what is special about our state. In the movement/activity room, we will play tag, marbles, Kick the Can, hopscotch, and jacks. Our art projects will include weaving and broom making. Our special snack will be tea cookies.

#### JULY 8-12 —MOUNTAINEERS

Let's head for the hills! Campers will enjoy songs by the campfire! In story time, we will read Grandma Gatewood Hikes the Appalachian Trail. In the movement/activity room, we will try some clogging and square dancing. Our art projects will include making a compass. Snacks this week will be teddy grahams and rainbow trout (rainbow goldfish).

#### JULY 15-19—THRILL SEEKERS

We will learn about Tweetsie, Carowinds, the White Water Center, and the Land of Oz this week. We will start our day with songs like "We're Off to See the Wizard" and "Love Train." During story time, we will hear books like The Wizard of Oz and Curious George and the Rollers Coaster. In the movement/activity room, we will pretend to be on a raft while we get sprayed with water and play Twister. For art we will make trains and a paper hot air balloon. For snacks we will make train tracks out of pretzels and have megaphones (Bugles).

#### JULY 22-26 —FACT SEEKERS

This week we will learn about some our local museums like Discovery Place, ImagiON, Nature Museum, and NASCAR .We will listen to the theme song of CARS and play Red Light, Green Light. During story time, we will act out a story from our school library. In the movement/activity room, we will play "Molecule Freeze" and have an obstacle course with tires. Making slime and a bubble potion will be our art projects. Our snacks will be rice krispy treats and edible slime (Jell-O).

#### JULY 29- AUG 2 —ZOOLOGISTS

There's a tiger on the loose! We will have a blast dancing to the theme song from "Madagascar" and play animal charades. During story time, we will enjoy Curious George Visits the Zoo. In the movement/activity room, we will do some animal yoga and pass the banana. For art we will make a zoo keeper. Our snacks will include oranges and animal crackers

#### AUG 5- 9 —CAROLINIANS

During our last week of camp, we will recap our summer highlights from going to the State Fair, to the beach, to the mountains, and to a professional sporting event. We will enjoy a variety of fair games, campfire songs, animal games, and beach fun. In story time, we will hear stories about our state fair and read Road Trip Carolina. In the movement/activity room, we will try some sack races and ring toss. Our art will be a Ferris wheel and a state flag. Our snacks this week will be caramel apples and soft pretzels.
